Objective:

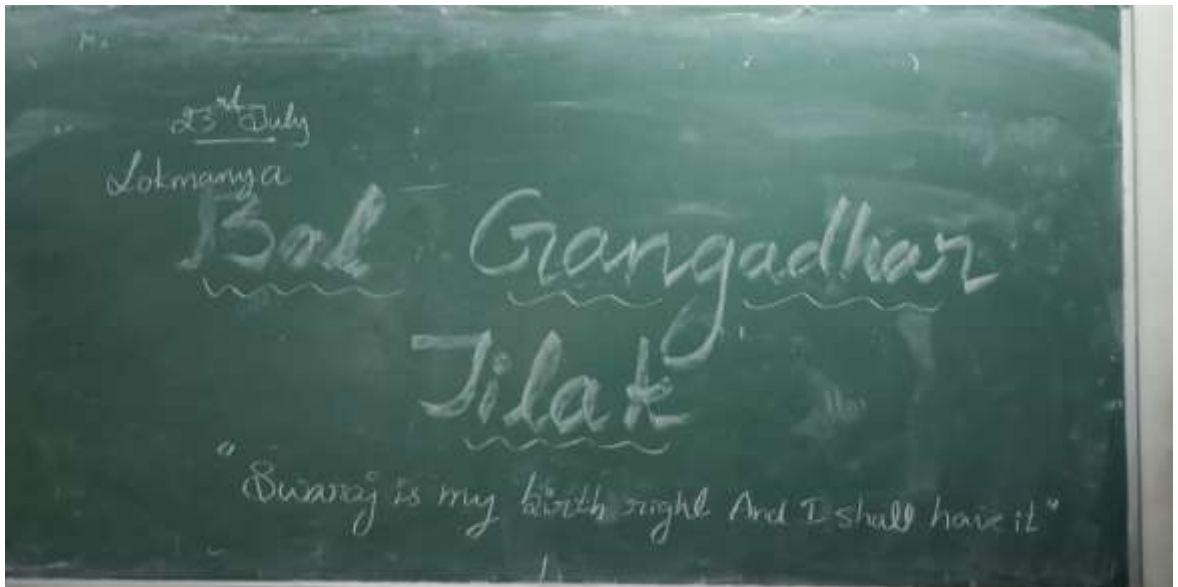
- ❖ The main objective of the event was to create awareness among the students about Bal Gangadhar Tilak and his struggle for the nation development..
