## Water Camp

## Pulse Polio

First Phase of Pulse Polio Program: On the 19<sup>th</sup> January by 6.00AM more than 400 students gathered near Health Centre koti. All the NSS Volunteers were sent to different Pulse Polio booths surrounding Koti, Sultan Bazar, Chaderghat, Bogulkunta. This is first time in the history of Pulse Polio where more than 400 NSS Volunteers participated. All the staff from the Medical Department appreciated our efforts. The program concluded at 6.00PM.

Pulse Polio Program at adopted village Begumpet: On 19<sup>th</sup> January 2014 more than 5 NSS Volunteers went to Begumpet village which is a adopted village under NSS Aurora. Around 10.00AM they went to the village Community hall and helped the village committee and Anganwadi workers for the Pulse Polio Program. At 10.30 AM all our NSS volunteers went to the Medical health center and brought all the materials and vaccine. More than 200 children were given vaccine.

Second Phase of Pulse Polio Program: On 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2014 again the health Govt staff requested us to coordinate the Second Pulse Polio program. More than 100 NSS volunteers participated in the Second Phase of Pulse Polio Program. On that day NSS volunteers gathered at Koti at 6.30AM. All volunteers dispersed to different Polio booths surrounding areas like Koti, Sultan bazar, Chaderghat and Santosh Nagar.

Pulse Polio Program at adopted village: On 19<sup>th</sup> January 2014 more than 5 NSS Volunteers went to Begumpet village which is a adopted village under NSS Aurora. At 10.00AM they went to the village Community hall and helped the village committee and Anganwadi workers for the Pulse Polio Program. The polio vaccine protects your child against polio or poliomyelitis, which is a highly infectious viral disease spread through infected people. The polio virus enters through the mouth and ends up in the nervous system. It can rapidly lead to paralysis and even death. India is one of the four remaining countries that have affected children. At 10.30 AM all our NSS volunteers went to the Medical Health Centre and brought all the materials and vaccine. More than 200 children have been given vaccine.

### **She Teams Annual Celebrations**

Objectives: To provide safety and security to women who are at home and working professions who are at home and working in different professions.


In this regard "She teams Annual celebrations was organized in collaboration with Swift E learning Services launched a free-e-learning module for citizens to raise public awareness regarding women's safety on October 26<sup>th</sup> at RTC Kala Bhavan. The event began with the launch of She Teams in the city , thee – learning course was launched by Home Minister Mr. Nayani Narasimha Reddy along with city police commissioner of police Avinash Mohanty. Tollywood actress Lavanya Tripathi, was also part of the event. The event was attended by nearly 1,200 students from various colleges. Aurora's Degree College also extended its support by volunteering for the event. The guests discussed about the protection of women and the measures to be taken for their defence. After the discussion the session was opened to the audience where they raised several questions and expressed their views on the same. There were other cultural programs which highlighted the event.

### **Green Holi**

Initiated in March 2012, on the eve of Holi, the students sold 1.5 tonnes of natural colours in association with Hyderabad Goes Green and National Agricultural Innovation Project- 'ANGRAU'. As part of Green Holi, a video was prepared for YouTube that was watched by thousands. Also our students opened a counter to sell natural colours by explaining the importance of Natural Colours

### **Help desk at Gandhi Hospital**

Aurora volunteers have been working with YouSee in maintenance of equipment, physical infrastructure like toilets, cots etc. The volunteers restored many unused equipment, painted walls and cots to be re-used again. Also they volunteered many activities like help desk, Medical reports data analysis, and Play activities in Padiatric department with Talasamia patients etc.



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Women Empowerment Cell ( WEC ) first conducted Orientation programme to make the students understand the objective of having a cell i.e. to create an environment where women can make independent decisions on their personal development as well as shine in their professional life and encouraged both boys and girls to join in the cell. 120 students joined the cell.

On 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2015, WEC conducted an Inspiring lecture by Ms.Vimala – poet, writer, advocate and activist. She talked about how to develop confidence, promoting independent thinking, dealing with sexual harassment. 121 students attended the programme and appreciated it.

On 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2016, WEC conducted a workshop on 'Security For Women and Self Defence Techniques' in collaboration with SHE TEAMS and Hyderabad City Police at Victory Indoor Stadium, Chaaderghat. The purpose of conducting this workshop is to empower young girls of various colleges in the twin cities, to be assertive and to guard themselves better through the self defence techniques taught to them at the workshop.


